Developments in our area

Planning has been submitted for Dundrum Central, on a much reduced scale to that communicated in the LDA master plan. Details at <http://www.dundrumcentralresidential.ie>

Planning for the old Dundrum shopping centre site has also been submitted and can be seen here <https://dundrumvillageshd.ie>. This proposal will have a significant impact on the Dundrum village.

Any resident who has a view on these development can make a submission or observations to An Bord Pleanála. These have to be made within 5 weeks of March 30 for Dundrum Hospital site and within 5 weeks of April 4 for Dundrum village.

There are a number of other developments planned for our area over coming years. Along with other local residents' associations we will continue to engage DLR and local representatives to help ensure community concerns are well communicated.

Parking

In March 2019, the committee submitted to DLR the results of our poll to review parking. Next steps are with DLR, to progress a feasibility survey and implementation report. Once this is completed the council will organise a formal ballot with all residents.

A recent follow up with DLR indicated that our request for review will be progressed in due course. There are a number of requests ahead of our submission being worked through. A parking management system has recently been introduced in Mulvey Park.

Subscription Fee

Voluntary subscription fees are necessary to meet the modest expenses associated with running the residents' association. For households who can, we would be grateful to collect €20.
